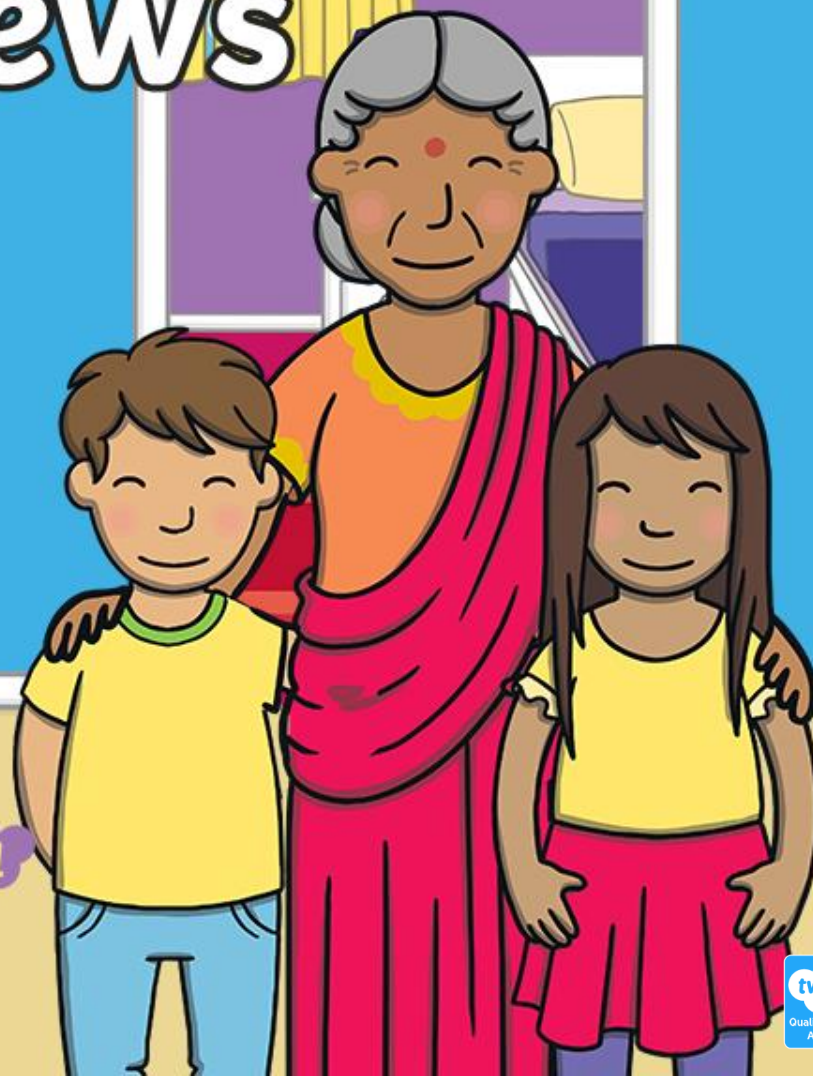

girl

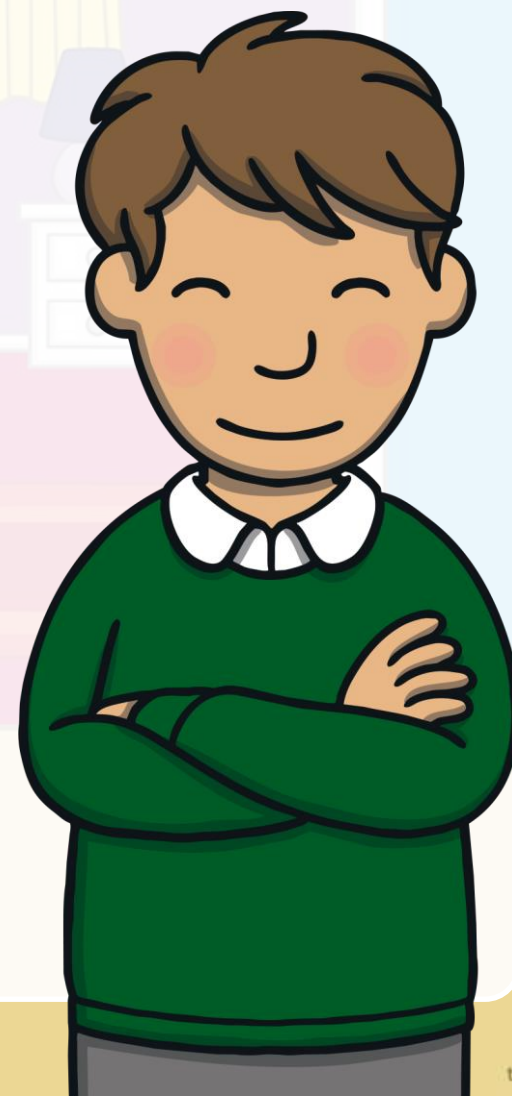
stir

We have already learnt the sound /er/ using the graphemes 'er' and 'ur'. The sound /er/ can also be made using the grapheme /ir/.

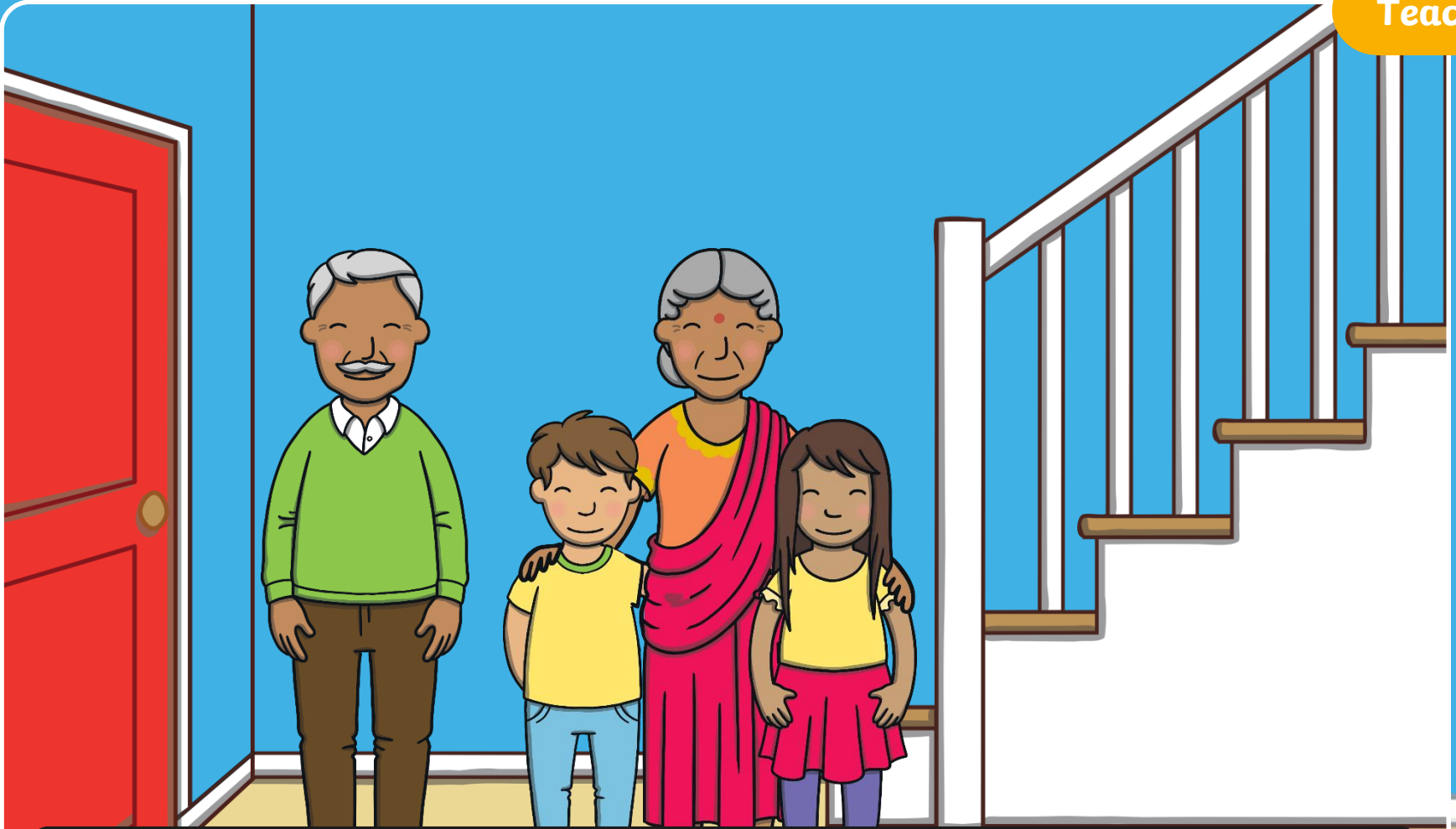

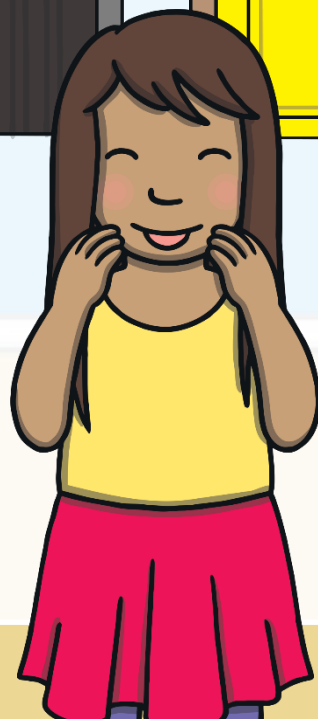


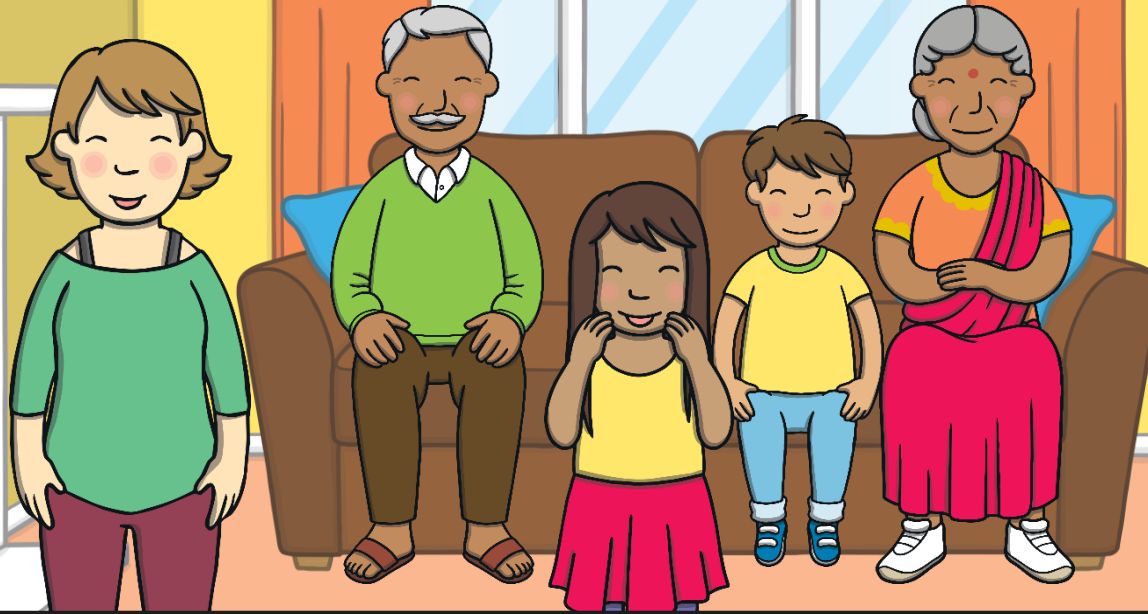
“Your Uncle and Aunt have been over from India visiting family for the last few months. Yesterday, Aunt Aditi gave birth to a beautiful little girl!

Can you read the words?







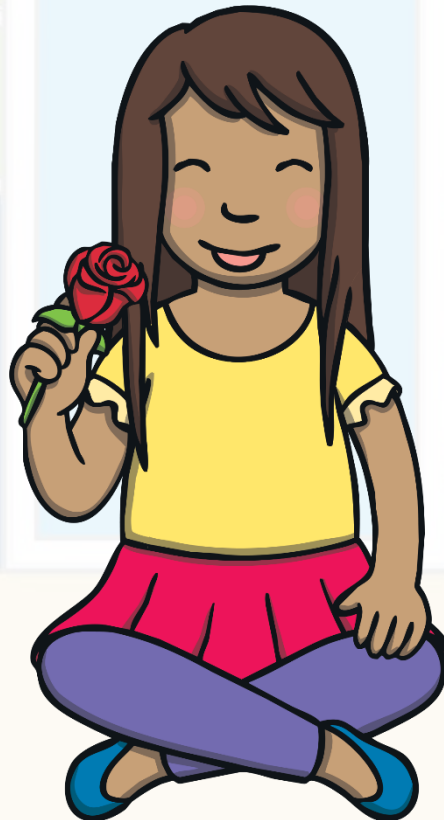
“So, we have a new girl cousin?” asked Sam enthusiastically.

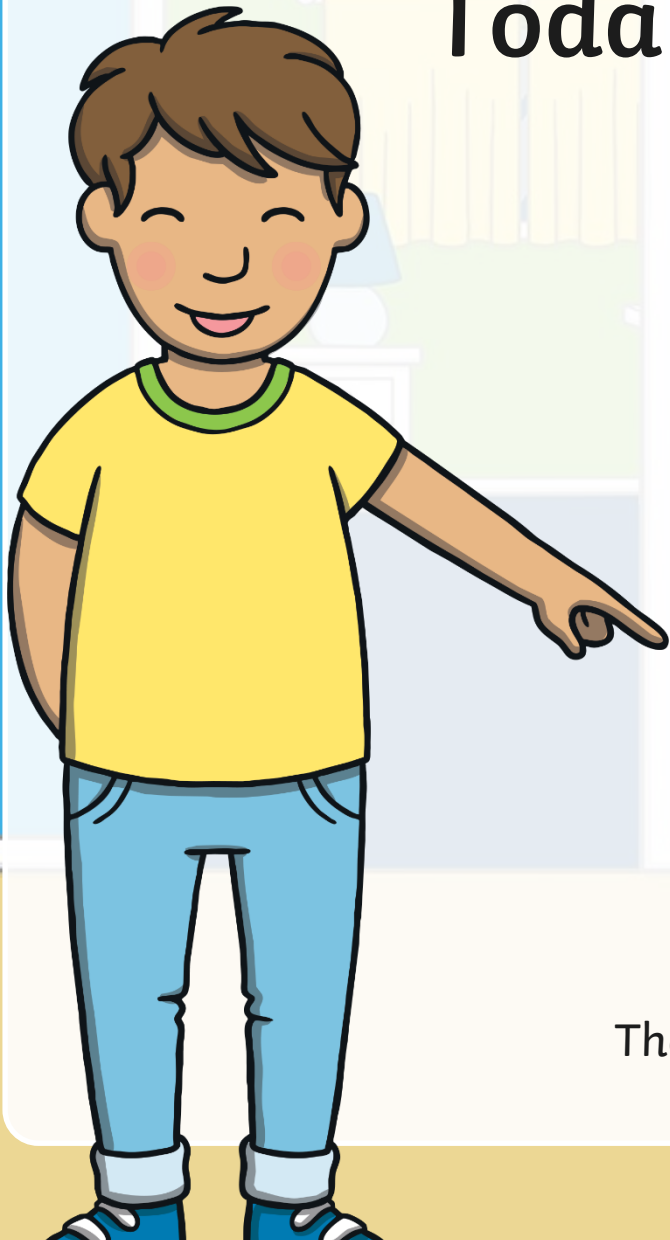




“Oh love, that was wonderful!” clapped Grandpa Dada.
