Booking is on a first come, first served basis, but please be mindful we would like all children to have the opportunity to attend at least one club and therefore ask you only book for a maximum of two clubs per child. We reserve the right to amend bookings if required and you will be notified if this is necessary. Please talk to your children about the clubs offered so they can choose with you those in which they have an interest so they gain maximum benefit from their extra-curricular activity.

We expect children to continue with their club choice for the full long term. We will endeavour to run the clubs every week within the dates given but please check the newsletter for any unforeseen cancellations or clashes. The adult running the club will dismiss all children attending from the main gate in the playground. We will assume parents will collect their children after their clubs unless notified otherwise.
